Intensive Surveys Needed

Marion (71 square miles) – Planned for 2018 & 2019 in two phases.

Clinton (41 square miles) – Planned for 2020.

Willow Springs (54 square miles) – Funded with HPF2018 grant. RFP needed.

Reconnaissance Surveys needed/or under way

Marion (71 square miles) – Northern portion of township underway May 2018

A portion of Willow Springs Township West of 900 Road to Marion Township line – underway May 2018.
